We would like as many artists as possible to submit at least one work based on Lichfield's Historic Buildings. (This is not a condition of entry)

In order to have a balanced exhibition and to enable as many members as possible to exhibit, other subjects can be submitted as in previous LSA exhibitions.

Some changes have been made to the T's & C's & the entry forms: -

- Membership fees need to have been paid by 10th May i.e. before you have submitted your entry for the June exhibition.
- Hanging fees must be paid when you submit your entry. If paying online, please ensure you list the payment as ENTRY & your membership number. Your membership number remains the same from year to year. In order for the handing in process to run more efficiently you will NOT be able to pay the hanging fee(s) on that day.
- You can submit a reserve painting. There is no hanging fee as there is no guarantee that it will be shown. If the picture is sold the normal 20% commission is payable. Please mark the label on the back with an **R** or reserve to indicate it is your reserve piece
- Since Covid we have encouraged members to exhibit again by showing work that had been
 previously exhibited. For the June exhibition all work must be new & recent and not exhibited
 in any previous LSA exhibitions.
- Please note we are introducing a "shop" area. Any sales will be subject to 20% commission. You must download and fill in the pro-forma so that an accurate record can be kept of work submitted and sales.

We remain an inclusive society for people of **all** abilities encouraging all members to participate in exhibitions. We will require **everyone** to present their work mounted and framed to a high standard. If you are new to exhibiting, please do ask if you need help or advice on presenting your work.

Terms and Conditions for Entry for the Lichfield Society of Artists Exhibition June 2023

Please ensure that you pay your membership fee by the 10th May 2023 to qualify to enter work in the June exhibition.

Please read these terms and conditions carefully before filling out your entry form.

Insurance.

One of the benefits of membership of the society is that it enjoys public liability insurance cover when you exhibit your 2D artwork in an exhibition organised by the society. However, individual items are not covered against theft or damage and need to be separately insured by the artist if required. Please note that 3D items are no longer covered by the society public liability insurance, members are advised to find their own cover and send a copy of the schedule when submitting their entry form to Barbara.

General Exhibition Rules and conditions of entry

It must be new work, and not shown in previous autumn and spring LSA exhibition.

It is of a size that can be accommodated in the space available.

It complies with all national and international copyright legislation.

It does not contain pornographic material

It is the exhibitor's own original work (i.e., not a print or reproduction.) However, Lino prints, Screen prints etc may be exhibited and should be signed and numbered with the print run—e.g., 1/10—or artists' proof. Digital artwork should be printed out on quality paper and framed for exhibition. Reproductions of original work, e.g. Giclee prints, may be displayed in the browser.

Presentation

Exhibits should be submitted unwrapped and clearly labelled on the back with the title of the work, price, artist's name and telephone number. Works not intended for sale should be clearly marked "NFS". WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF IT DOES NOT HAVE A LABEL ON THE BACK. Unframed paintings for the browser should be mounted, wrapped in clear film, and clearly labelled as above.

Picture frames must be fitted with 'D' rings and properly strung. Frames with a single centre hook are not accepted. Presentation, mounting, and framing MUST be of a high standard.

Stewarding: It is a condition of entry for main exhibitions that exhibitors may be called upon to act as stewards at least once during the exhibition. Another person may be nominated to steward in the exhibitor's place. Availability for stewarding should be notified to the exhibition organiser at the time of entry.

Removal of Exhibits: Exhibits may only be removed at times previously notified on exhibition entry forms. The Society cannot be held responsible for artwork not collected. Such work may be subject to a handling fee. Work not collected within 6 months of exhibition end may be disposed of.

All work sold during an exhibition will be subject to sales commission of 20% of the sale price. Payment for sales will be made within 30 days of the close of the exhibition.

Prizes All award winners receive a certificate. Many dedicated awards receive a trophy which must be returned in time for the following year's exhibition.

Paintings/framed works. Max 20" (including frame) £3.

Larger paintings (subject to space available) over 20"in any direction. £6.

<u>Unframed paintings.</u> (for the browser). Maximum 5 pieces. No fee, but the usual commission is applied.

Reserve painting. Artists are invited to submit a "reserve" work. Please mark R on the label

The Art shop. Small items can now be sold on a table at the exhibition. Please download the entry proforma invoice to itemise your items this can be handed in on 16th June when you deliver your work.
