- Photo: Image to be .jpg and no more than 2mb in size. Ensure that the image is cropped so the frame / mount is not visible or if it is, that the image does not show any background around the frame.
- Artist Statement. Max 100 words
- Medium/Materials. Max 25 words

- Societies/ Groups. The number submitted will affect the space available for the image
- Email / social media email address and icons required, such as Facebook, Instagram.
- The size of the image on the printed page will be dependent on space required for the amount of Society/group memberships and social media icons.

Terms and Conditions for Entry for the Lichfield Society of Artists Exhibition

20th – 22nd October 2023

Exhibition is for members only.

Please read these terms and conditions carefully before filling out your entry form.

Insurance.

One of the benefits of membership of the society is that it enjoys public liability insurance cover when you exhibit your 2D artwork in an exhibition organised by the society. However, individual items are not covered against theft or damage and need to be separately insured by the artist if required. **Please note that 3D items are no longer covered, members are advised find their own cover and send a copy of the schedule when submitting their entry form to Barbara.**

General Exhibition Rules and conditions of entry

It must be new work, and not shown in previous LSA exhibitions.

It is of a size that can be accommodated in the space available.

It complies with all national and international copyright legislation

It does not contain pornographic material

It is the exhibitor's own original work (i.e., not a print or reproduction.) However, Lino prints, Screen prints etc may be exhibited and should be signed and numbered with the print run—e.g., 1/10—or artists' proof. Digital artwork should be printed out on quality paper and framed for exhibition. Reproductions of original work, e.g., Giclee prints, may be displayed in the browser.

Presentation

Exhibits should be submitted unwrapped and clearly labelled on the back with the title of the work, price, artist's name and telephone number. Works not intended for sale should be clearly marked "NFS".

WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF IT DOES NOT HAVE A LABEL ON THE BACK. Unframed paintings for the browser should be mounted, wrapped in clear film, and clearly labelled as above.

Picture frames must be fitted with 'D' rings and properly strung. Frames with a single centre hook are not accepted. Presentation, mounting, and framing **MUST** be of a high standard.

Stewarding

It is a condition of entry for main exhibitions that exhibitors act as stewards at least once during the exhibition. Another person may be nominated to steward in the exhibitor's place. Availability for stewarding should be notified to the exhibition organiser at the time of entry see space on form.

Removal of Exhibits: Exhibits may only be removed at times previously notified on exhibition entry forms. The Society cannot be held responsible for artwork not collected. Such work may be subject to a handling fee. Work not collected within 6 months of exhibition end may be disposed of.

All work sold during an exhibition will be subject to sales commission of 20% of the sale price. Payment for sales will be made within 30 days of the close of the exhibition.

Prizes All award winners receive a certificate. Awards that receive a trophy are held for one year and then returned to the society

Framed Paintings. Max 20inch (51cm) £3. Over 20inch (in any direction) £6.

Max. 3 pieces but subject to space being available.

Unframed paintings. No fee, but usual 20% commission is applied. Maximum 5

Ceramics and sculpture. Large single items £6 each Small single item £3 each

A table can be booked for several items at a fee of £10. Limited availability

Artists to provide a copy of their own public liability insurance for 3D pieces

Shop and cards. No fee but commission paid. Please download a pro-forma invoice, fill in all your items (all with number & initials) and hand in with your goods.

Take a copy to check when you collect all unsold items.

Hanging fees with form please, either by bank transfer, mark your payment with your membership number, e.g., Entry 32, payable to Lichfield society of Artists, sort code-30-90-09, Acc 50760360.
